Sioe Llanarthne Show- Format of Show Day

Traditionally, our Show Day has followed a well-established format of the show on the field during the day followed by a separate evening concert in the Hall. Attendees were asked to pay entry to the show field for the main show and a separate ticketed entry cost to the evening concert in the hall.

In pursuit of our ambition for greater inclusivity and participation, offering great family value, this year we are changing to a new show day format. The Show day commences as normal with the early morning submission of competition entries in the Hall followed by the all important judging. At Noon the gates open for the start of our main ring show at 12.30pm. Our show then continues seamlessly through to dusk with a great variety of activities, events and games culminating with music and entertainment, **all on the field**. To support this variety of on-field entertainment a range of food vendors and a fully licensed Bar will be present. In addition, a broad range of exhibitors will be present offering the opportunity to purchase a diverse range of products and gifts. This whole day and evening of family entertainment is being offered for the same adult ticket price as for the show only last year.

As a result of our Sunroom extension to the Hall we are able to offer significantly greater capacity for competition entries including the addition of a new Art section this year. Our schedule contains full details of the exciting range of competitions for 2026.

6. No exhibits to be removed before 5pm.
7. The Show Committee does not take any responsibility for damage or loss that may occur to property or persons.
8. Previous winning entries at Llanarthne Show cannot be re-entered this year.

2026 SET RECIPE- CHOCOLATE ORANGE DRIZZLE CAKE

Ingredients for the Cake

175g (6oz) butter, softened,
175g (6oz) caster sugar
3 large eggs
Grated rind of 2 oranges
175g (6oz) self-raising flour, sifted,
2 tablespoons of milk

Ingredients for the topping

The juice of 2 oranges
100g (4oz) granulated sugar
50g (2oz) milk or plain chocolate
Makes 1: 900g (2lb) loaf or 17.5 (7 inch) round cake

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 180 degrees C, 350 degrees F, gas mark 4.
2. Grease & line either of the tins.
3. Cream together the butter & sugar until light & fluffy.
4. Add the eggs, one at a time & beat well.
5. Add the grated orange rind, flour & milk & fold in with a metal spoon.
6. Turn into the prepared tin, smooth the top & bake for 30 - 40 minutes until a skewer comes out clean.
7. Remove from the oven & leave to cool in the tin.
8. When cool, score the top of the cake lightly with a sharp knife.
9. Put the orange juice & granulated sugar into a pan & heat gently until the sugar has dissolved.
10. Bring to the boil & boil for 1-2 minutes.
11. Pour over the cake.
12. When all the juice has soaked in, carefully remove the cake from the tin.
13. Melt the chocolate & pour over the top.
14. Make a pattern with the prongs of a fork & leave to set.
15. Delicious eaten with a cup of tea or a mug of coffee.
